Upon receiving your primary e-application we will send you further instructions, as well as an admission letter (upon request).

**Please note, primary e-application is a primary application of copies of key documents via e-mail. It cannot be deemed an application for admission to the University, rather an application for an admission letter or a visa invitation (if applicable). Admission letter is just a reminder for an applicant. It cannot be deemed a confirmation of admission to the University or any other type of official document imposing any obligations on the University.*

Selection criteria

- Specialist's or bachelor's degree applicants must have complete secondary general education.
- Master's degree applicants must have higher education of any level.
- Ph.D. degree applicants must have at least a completed higher education (a specialist's or master's degree).
- Education and qualifications of all applicants must be confirmed by appropriate certificates, which are valid in the Russian Federation.
- All applicants must have an appropriate level of the Russian and/or English language to pass entry examinations and complete the course successfully.

Required documents

for INTERNATIONAL applicants

The following original documents among others*
are required to be provided to the Admission Committee:

1. Notarized translation of your passport into Russian.
2. Education certificate with consular legalization or bearing the Apostille stamp.

Please note, education certificates obtained in the Russian Federation do not require legalization, Apostille stamps or Certificates of Recognition.
3. Notarized translation of the education certificate into Russian.
4. Certificate of recognition of foreign education. It is provided by the Main State Center for Education Evaluation (Glavekspertcentr). Here you will find information on how to get the Certificate of Recognition: <http://nic.gov.ru/en/proc/nic>.
5. Certificate of absence of HIV-1 infection translated into the Russian language.
6. Medical form of eligibility for studying in Russia.

Important!


A medical certificate must contain results of the health checkup in accordance with the list of medical specialists, laboratory tests and instrumental examinations specified by the regulation of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation from April 12, 2011 N302n "Approval of the lists of occupational hazards and works, which require compulsory initial and subsequent health checkups and the Rules of conducting compulsory initial and subsequent health checkups for workers performing difficult work or working in hazardous conditions“.

Important!

- Application shall be submitted to the University Admission Committee in Moscow personally, via an authorized representative, or via any public postal service.
- Applicants who apply personally or via an authorized representatives will be issued a filing receipt.
- In case an application is made by a public postal service, it will accepted only if it is delivered to the University not later than the last day of an admission period.
- **All the documents issued in a foreign country shall be legalized prior to submission** in accordance with the law of the Russian Federation: undergo consular legalization (in the Consulate of the Russian Federation in the country where the document was issued) or bear an Apostille stamp (for documents issued in the countries that are parties to the Hague Convention). **Original documents rather than their copies should be legalized!**

1. A special discipline* relevant to the chosen Ph.D. programme;
2. A foreign language**.

*A special discipline exam can be conducted in Russian or English according to an applicant's choice.

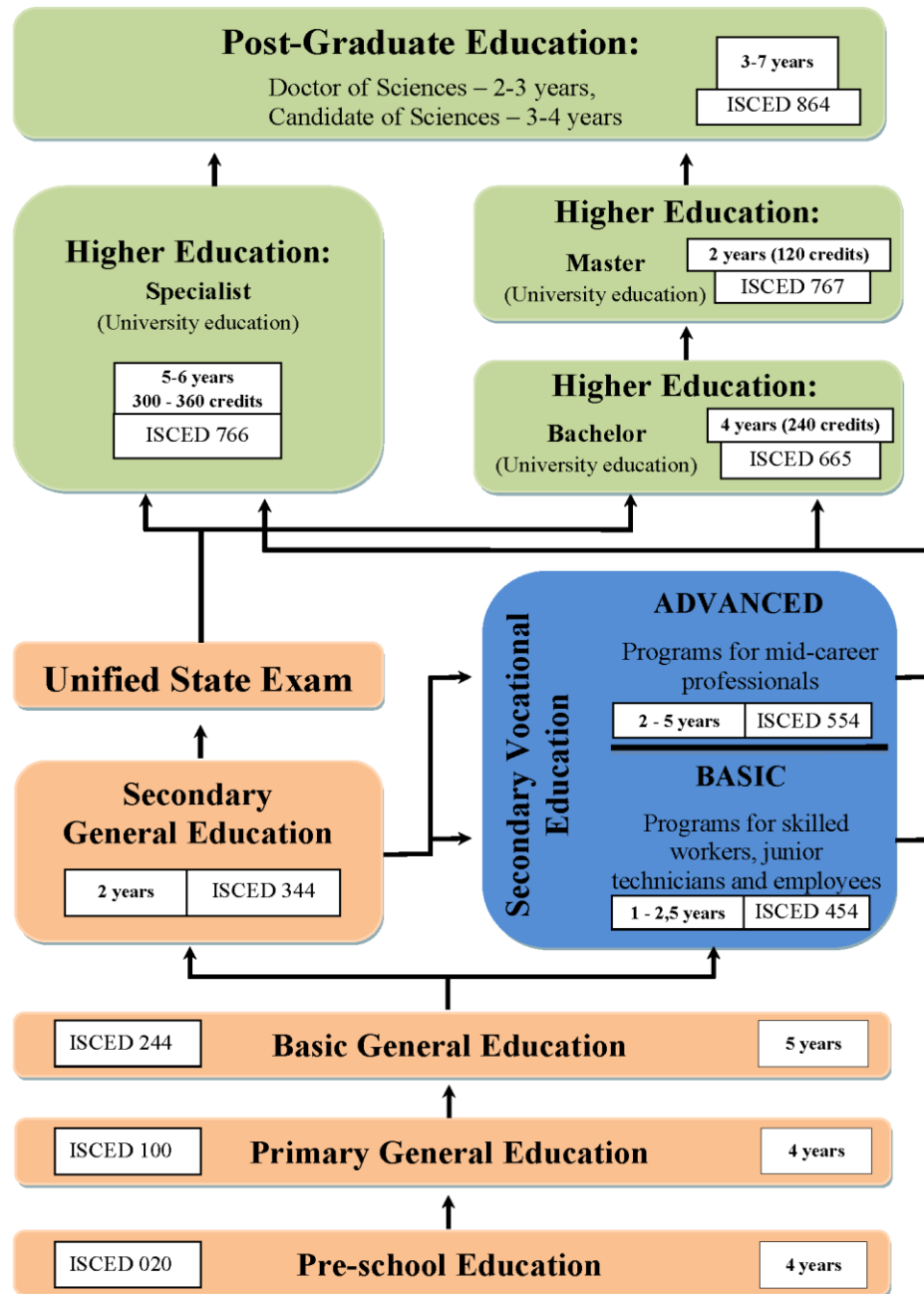
**A foreign language exam allows an applicant to choose between the Russian language, the English language, or the German language to be examined.

It is not possible for an applicant to choose a foreign language being official in the country of the applicant's citizenship.
