# Why enter?


The Olympiad brings students together from around the world to compete, learn and share ideas using English, the lingua franca of global healthcare.

### **How does it work?**

The first rounds are online. The final round is in Moscow, at Sechenov Medical University, Russia's leading medical school.

#### **Entry** is free.

**Qualifying round:** a simple online grammar and vocabulary test to assess your general English level, to take place on 29th November 2019

**Round 1:** online listening and reading tests to assess your ability to work with Medical English at a higher level, to take place on 5th December 2019

**Round 2:** video presentations – choose from a variety of topics to make an outstanding presentation of up to 5 minutes. To be judged by an international panel of experts. Closing date 31st December 2019.

**Final:** come to Moscow, where you work in teams with other finalists to create and deliver a live presentation in front of international judges and other participants, to take place in Medical Education week in early April 2020. Accommodation, city tour, visa support and plenty of fantastic Russian hospitality all included.

#### Teams: undergraduates, postgraduates and residents

Teams up to 6 members (the captain and up to five team members) submit video presentations from a set of topics by 31st December 2019. Videos to be judged by an international panel. Captains of the winning teams will be invited to join the individual finalists in Moscow for the Final.
